



## Code of Conduct for Junior North Belfast Harriers

Junior athletes should always:

- Treat Sports Leaders with respect.
- Play fairly at all times, do their best.
- Respect team members, even when things go wrong.
- Respect opponents, be gracious in defeat.
- Abide by the rules set down by Athletics NI and their club.
- Talk to the Coach or Club Safeguarding Officer if they have any problems.
- Wear suitable clothing and footwear for training sessions whatever the weather.

Junior athletes should never:

- Cheat.
- Use violence.
- Shout or argue with officials, team mates or opponents.
- Use physical contact that is not allowed within the rules.
- Harm team members, opponents or their property.
- Bully or use bullying tactics to isolate another person.
- Use bad language.
- Take banned substances.
- Keep secrets about anyone who may have caused them harm.
- Tell lies about adults/young people.
- Spread rumours.
- Behave in a manner that may bring Athletics NI or North Belfast Harriers into disrepute.
